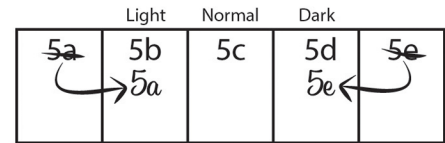
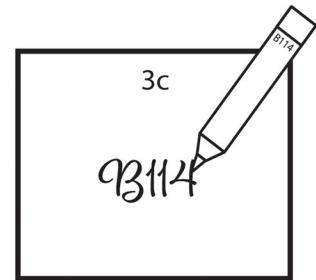


Tips to make the most of this page:
